NAMES RELEASED OF FATAL ACCIDENT – MEADVIEW

Mohave County Sheriff's deputies responded to a two vehicle injury accident that occurred on Diamond Bar Road at milepost .5, near Pierce Ferry Road, Monday (8/30) morning. At about 10:45 a.m. deputies responded to the scene of where a Dodge Charger passenger vehicle and a Ford F350 truck were involved in a head on collision. The Dodge was traveling east on Diamond Bar Road when the vehicle crossed over the center striped line and collided with the Ford which was traveling westbound. All four occupants in the Dodge Charger were wearing seatbelts and are tourist from Australia. The Dodge Charger was driven by Hector Anstis, 69, with a front passenger of Graeme Mann, 69. Both men were airlifted to Sunrise Medical Center in Las Vegas in critical condition by Care Flight. Both rear seated passengers did not survive the accident and are identified as Annette Anstis, 67, and Robyn Mann.

The driver of the truck identified as Angela Hazelton, 47, of Kingman was transported via an ambulance to Kingman Regional Medical Center.

Both vehicles were towed from the scene. This accident remains under investigation.

WARRANTS ARREST – FORT MOHAVE

Mohave County Sheriff's deputies arrested Kellie Suzanne Farrell, 46, of Fort Mohave, on outstanding warrants early Monday (8/30) afternoon. At about 12:30 p.m., deputies contacted Farrell at a residence in the 2000 block of Moon Mountain Place. A record check showed Farrell to have two misdemeanor warrants issued by Bullhead City Justice Court for failure to appear on original charges of no dog licenses and over limit of dogs. Farrell was taken into custody without incident. She was transported and booked into the Mohave County District II Substation.

DRUGS/DRUG PARAPHERNALIA – KINGMAN

Mohave County Sheriff's deputies arrested Gavin Patrick Vanderbeck, 21, and Latecia Tubbs, 18, both of Kingman, Monday (8/30) evening. Vanderbeck was arrested for possession of narcotic drugs, possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia, felonies. Tubbs was arrested for possession of narcotic drugs and possession of drug paraphernalia, felonies. Deputies observed a vehicle traveling reckless in the area of Rusty Spur and Famoso Drive. The vehicle was speeding and running through stop signs. Approximately 10:25 p.m., deputies conducted a traffic stop on Famoso Drive at Double O Drive and detained the driver identified as Vanderbeck. A search of Vanderbeck revealed a plastic bag containing a small chunk of a sticky substance which field tested for heroin. Deputies had the passenger, identified as Tubbs, exit the vehicle. A search of the vehicle revealed a plastic bag containing marijuana, a razor blade and two scales. The marijuana weighed approximately 2.93 ounces. Located on the passenger floorboard was a purse belonging to Tubbs. Deputies found Tubbs to be in possession of a plastic bag containing a black sticky substance which field tested for heroin. Tubbs was taken into custody without incident. Vanderbeck and Tubbs were transported and booked into the Mohave County Jail. The vehicle was towed from the scene.
